*Poor sanitary conditions in markets can be a source of transmission of various diseases, namely Cholera, Typhus, Hepatitis A, Filariasis/Elephantiasis, Leptospirosis, plague, Scrub typhus, Leishmaniasis, Murine typhus, Chagas disease, Angiostrongyliasis and Schistosomiasis and several other diseases. Existing problems at Beran Market namely, not all kiosks have waste containers, kiosks do not have places to wash hands with soap, bathrooms still smell, there are no waste water disposal installation facilities, and markets are not free from vectors. The aim of this research is to assess market sanitation (water, sanitation, hygiene needs, bathrooms, waste management, waste water drainage, waste water treatment installations, hand washing facilities, control of vectors and disease-carrying animals, quality food and groceries, and market disinfection).*

*This research uses descriptive methods with qualitative and quantitative approaches. Data was collected through direct observation, interviews and quality testing and measurement of sanitation aspects. With the PERMENKES No. 17 of 2020 concerning Healthy Markets.*

*The research results showed that the sanitation conditions at Beran Market still did not meet the requirements for 26 items (57%). It is hoped that the quality of sanitation will be improved (bathrooms, waste water drainage channels, waste water treatment plants, hand washing facilities, control of vectors and disease-carrying animals, quality of food and groceries as well as market disinfection).*
