“PERILAKU PENERAPAN PROTOKOL KESEHATAN DALAM PENCEGAHAN COVID-19 PADA PEDAGANG DI PASAR RAKYAT KEDUNGMALING KABUPATEN MOJOKERTO TAHUN 2022”

Penyakit COVID-19 menjadi tantangan dunia kesehatan saat ini termasuk di Indonesia yang masih menunjukkan peningkatan kasus setiap harinya. Penularan COVID-19 paling memungkinkan terjadi di tempat umum, salah satunya pasar tradisional. Pemerintah telah mengeluarkan kebijakan protokol kesehatan untuk masyarakat dalam menjalankan aktivitasnya agar dapat mengurangi serta memutus rantai penyebaran COVID-19. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui perilaku penerapan protokol kesehatan pada pedagang di Pasar Rakyat Kedungmaling Kabupaten Mojokerto Tahun 2022.

Penelitian ini menggunakan jenis penelitian deskriptif kualitatif dengan metode observasional. Data dianalisa statistik deskripsi yang disajikan dalam bentuk narasi, tabel, dan gambar. Teknik pengambilan sampel pada penelitian ini menggunakan pengambilan sampel acak sederhana. Pengumpulan data diperoleh dari data hasil kuesioner yang telah diisi oleh responden dan lembar observasi yang telah diisi oleh peneliti.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa tingkat pengetahuan pedagang baik sebesar 50%. Sikap pedagang memiliki sikap baik sebesar 60,4%. Ketersediaan sarana dan prasarana di pasar memiliki sarana dan prasarana baik sebesar 80%. Dukungan keluarga dan tokoh masyarakat pada pedagang memiliki dukungan baik sebesar 60,4%.

Kesimpulan dari penelitian ini adalah perilaku pedagang dalam penerapan protokol kesehatan baik, akan tetapi masih terdapat pedagang yang tidak menerapkan protokol kesehatan dengan baik dan benar. Hal ini disarankan kepada pengelola pasar yaitu melakukan penyuluhan dan edukasi terkait penerapan protokol kesehatan serta menyediakan fasilitas POS pelayanan kesehatan untuk mencegah terjadinya penyakit COVID-19.

BEHAVIOR OF IMPLEMENTATION OF HEALTH PROTOCOL IN PREVENTION OF COVID-19 ON TRADERS IN THE KEDUNGMALING MARKET, MOJOKERTO REGENCY IN 2022

COVID-19 disease was a challenge for the health world today, including in Indonesia, which was still showing an increase in cases every day. The transmission of COVID-19 was most likely to occur in public places, one of which is the traditional market. The government has issued a health protocol policy for the community in carrying out their activities in order to reduce and break the chain of spread of COVID-19. This study aims to assess the behavior of implementing health protocols on traders at the Kedungmaling People's Market, Mojokerto Regency In 2022.

This research used descriptive qualitative research with observational methods. The data were analyzed of descriptive statistics presented in the form of narration, tables, and pictures. The sampling method used was simple random sampling. Data collection was obtained from data from questionnaires that had been filled out by respondents and observation sheets that had been filled out by researchers.

The results of this study indicate that the level of knowledge of traders was good at 50%. Attitude traders have a good attitude of 60.4%. Availability of facilities and infrastructure in the market has good facilities and infrastructure were 80%. Family support and community leaders to traders have good support of 60.4%.

The conclusion of this study was that the behavior of traders in implementing health protocols is good, but there were still traders who do not apply health protocols properly and correctly. This is recommended to market managers, namely conducting counseling and education related to the implementation of health protocols and providing health service POS facilities to prevent the occurrence of COVID-19 disease.
