

ABSTRAK

Banyak wanita yang masih belum mengetahui dan melakukan pemeriksaan IVA. Ada beberapa faktor yang mempengaruhi kurangnya perilaku seseorang untuk melakukan deteksi dini kanker serviks antara lain sikap ibu. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui hubungan sikap ibu dengan keikutsertaan WUS dalam deteksi dini kanker serviks melalui IVA Test di Puskesmas Jenu Kabupaten Tuban tahun 2022.

Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah *analitik observasional* dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Variabel *independent* pada penelitian ini adalah sikap ibu dan variabel *dependent* keikutsertaan WUS. Penelitian ini menggunakan Teknik *probability sampling* dengan rancangan penelitian *simple random sampling*. Populasi pada penelitian ini adalah semua WUS yang berkunjung di Poli KB Puskesmas Jenu sebanyak 98 WUS. Sampel pada penelitian ini terdiri dari 78 WUS. Pengumpulan data menggunakan kuesioner sebagai instrumen penelitian. Hasil penelitian di analisis menggunakan Uji *Chi Square*.

Hasil analisis menunjukkan sebagian besar responden mempunyai sikap positif sebanyak 74,4%. Sebagian besar responden pernah melakukan IVA Test sebanyak 71,8 %. Hubungan sikap ibu dengan keikutsertaan WUS dalam deteksi dini kanker serviks melalui IVA Test hampir seluruh responden mempunyai sikap positif dan pernah melakukan IVA Test dalam 3 tahun terakhir sebanyak 53 responden (91,4%). Adapun sebagian kecil responden yang bersikap positif namun tidak pernah melakukan pemeriksaan IVA Test dalam 3 tahun terakhir sebanyak 5 responden (8,6%). Hasil Uji *Chi Square* didapatkan hasil nilai signifikan 0,000 atau $p \text{ value} < \alpha (0,05)$.

Dari hasil analisis menandakan adanya hubungan sikap ibu dengan keikutsertaan WUS dalam deteksi dini kanker serviks melalui IVA Test di Puskesmas Jenu. Diharapkan kepada pihak Puskesmas untuk mensosialisasikan pentingnya pemeriksaan IVA Test dengan penyuluhan yang mudah dipahami sehingga timbul sikap positif pada WUS bahwa sangat penting melakukan deteksi dini kanker serviks.

ABSTRACT

Many women still do not know and do an IVA examination. There are several factors that influence the lack of a person's behavior to perform early detection of cervical cancer, including the attitude of the mother. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between maternal attitudes and WUS participation in early detection of cervical cancer through the IVA test at the Jenu Health Center, Tuban Regency in 2022.

The type used in this research is an analytical survey with a cross sectional approach. The independent variable in this study was the mother's behaviour and the dependent variable was WUS participation. This study uses a probability sampling technique with a simple random sampling research. The population in this study were all WUS who visited the KB Poli KB Jenu Health Center as many as 98 WUS. The sample in this study consisted of 78 WUS. The data collected by using a questionnaire as a research instrument. The results of the study were analyzed using the Chi Square Test.

The results of the analysis obtained The mother's behaviour most of the respondents had a positive behaviour as much as 74.4%. The participation of WUS in early detection of cervical cancer, most of the respondents have done the IVA Test as much as 71.8%. The relation between mother's behaviour and WUS participation in early detection of cervical cancer through the IVA Test of 78 respondents, most of the respondents had a positive behaviour and had done an IVA Test in the last 3 years, specifically 53 respondents (91.4%). And some respondents who have a positive behaviour but have never done an IVA Test in the last 3 years as many as 5 respondents (8.6%). The results of the Chi Square test showed a significant value of 0.000 or p value < (0.05).

The results of the analysis indicate that there is a relation between maternal attitudes and WUS participation in early detection of cervical cancer through the IVA Test at the Jenu Health Center. So, the Puskesmas expected socialize the importance of the IVA Test examination with easy-to-understand counseling so that a positive behaviour arises in WUS that it is very important to do early detection of cervical cancer.
